New Managing Director for JOANNEUM RESEARCH

Heinz Mayer succeeds Wolfgang Pribyl as of 1 September 2021 and takes over the management of Austria's second largest non-university research organisation with headquarters in Graz.

Heinz Mayer (52) knows the company inside out, having previously headed the largest research unit at JOANNEUM RESEARCH, the DIGITAL Institute. He studied telematics at TU Graz, where he gained several years of experience as a university assistant. He then worked at Magna Steyr, including as head of the information management department. In 2007 Mayer moved to JOANNEUM RESEARCH and successfully acted as deputy institute director of DIGITAL, the Institute for Information and Communication Technologies, and as research group leader of the group "Image Analysis and Measurement Systems". In 2013, he took over the management of DIGITAL with 130 employees.

In the coming months, JOANNEUM RESEARCH will start preparing a new strategy document that will describe the path of the research company from 2023 onwards. "I am looking forward to the task of developing technologies for tomorrow together with the approximately 500 colleagues from different areas in order to provide solutions for the challenges of our time."

Digitisation is one of the major topics of the future, which must continue to be given special attention, especially in research.
